

# UIL Academic District 25-6A Meet Results

Westlake High School is the Academic District 25-6A Champion!

Westlake's lead on all other teams has been deemed insurmountable heading into the district speech and debate contest that takes place on Tuesday, April 2nd. Westlake has 412 points and the closest team is Jack C. Hays High School with 199 points (see the attached image).

Then, this past Tuesday, the **Computer Science** Team won the district championship, winning four of the top five individual places.
